## You Want Me To What? A Urine Sample? From My Cat!?

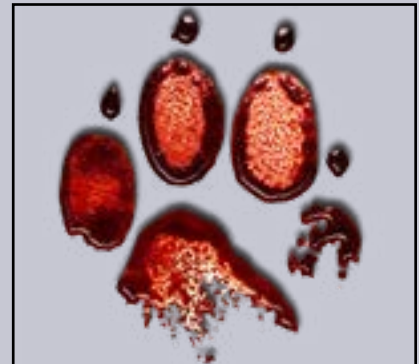

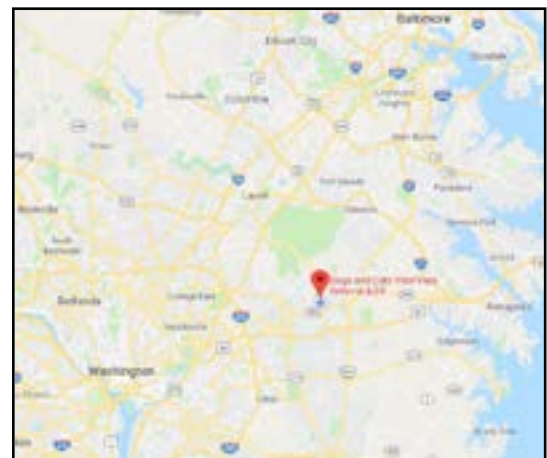


## Dog/Cat Food Recalls
